

## Graduate Programme in the Principles and Practical Application of Taxation: Intela (2) Training Programme

(Other provinces – only distance)**

The Intela 2 Training Programme is an exciting new opportunity for people working in a financial environment who are seeking to become professional tax practitioners and register as members of the South African Institute for Tax Professionals (SAIT).

The programme is presented on Saturday and classes will commence from May 2017 with extra after-hours tutor-assisted classes. Delegates will write a final examination administered by the University of Pretoria and a SAIT External Integrated Summative assessment in February 2018 to be able to register as professional members of SAIT upon successful completion.

Funded by Fasset (the Accounting and Finance Services SETA), the course is jointly managed by SAIT and the University of Pretoria. Training will take place in Pretoria and in Polokwane. All programme training costs are funded by Fasset. The programme will also be offered on a distance learner basis for learners from other provinces, other than Gauteng and Limpopo.

### **Admission requirements**

Prospective delegates should have 4 year's workplace experience in all relevant tax fields (VAT, PAYE, Individuals and corporate compliance) to be able to compile the SAIT workplace logbook, and a minimum of a Grade 12/NQF 4 qualification.

Preselected learners will be invited for an interview and need to be available for an interview between 17 April - 29 April 2017. The interview is done in order to select the final learners that will be accepted onto the programme.



### **Accreditation and certification**

Delegates who successfully complete the course and comply with the related assessment criteria are awarded certificates by the University of Pretoria in recognition of their professional skills development. Candidates that pass the EISA will be awarded the Occupational Certificate: Tax Technician by the Quality Council for Trades and Occupations (QCTO) as the

Regulatory Body. The Qualification will be recognised by SAIT for full membership and professional status. The Qualification leads to the designation Tax Technician (SA).
